DIRECTIONS

Papa-Razzi, 16 Washington Street, Wellesley, Massachusetts

From The North: 128S to exit 21B (Route 16). Take a right at the lights at the end of the ramp onto Route 16, Papa Razzi is less than 1/4 mile after the first set of lights on the left hand side, just past Dunkin Donuts.

From the South: 128N to exit 21 (Route 16). Take a left at the end of the ramp. Proceed through 2 sets of lights. Papa Razzi is less than 1/4 mile on the left hand side, just past Dunkin Donuts.

From East & West: Take Mass Pike to Route 95/128 exit. Follow 95/128 South about a mile to exit 21B (Route 16). Take a right at the end of the ramp. Papa Razzi is less than 1/4 mile after the first set of lights on the left hand side just past Dunkin Donuts.
